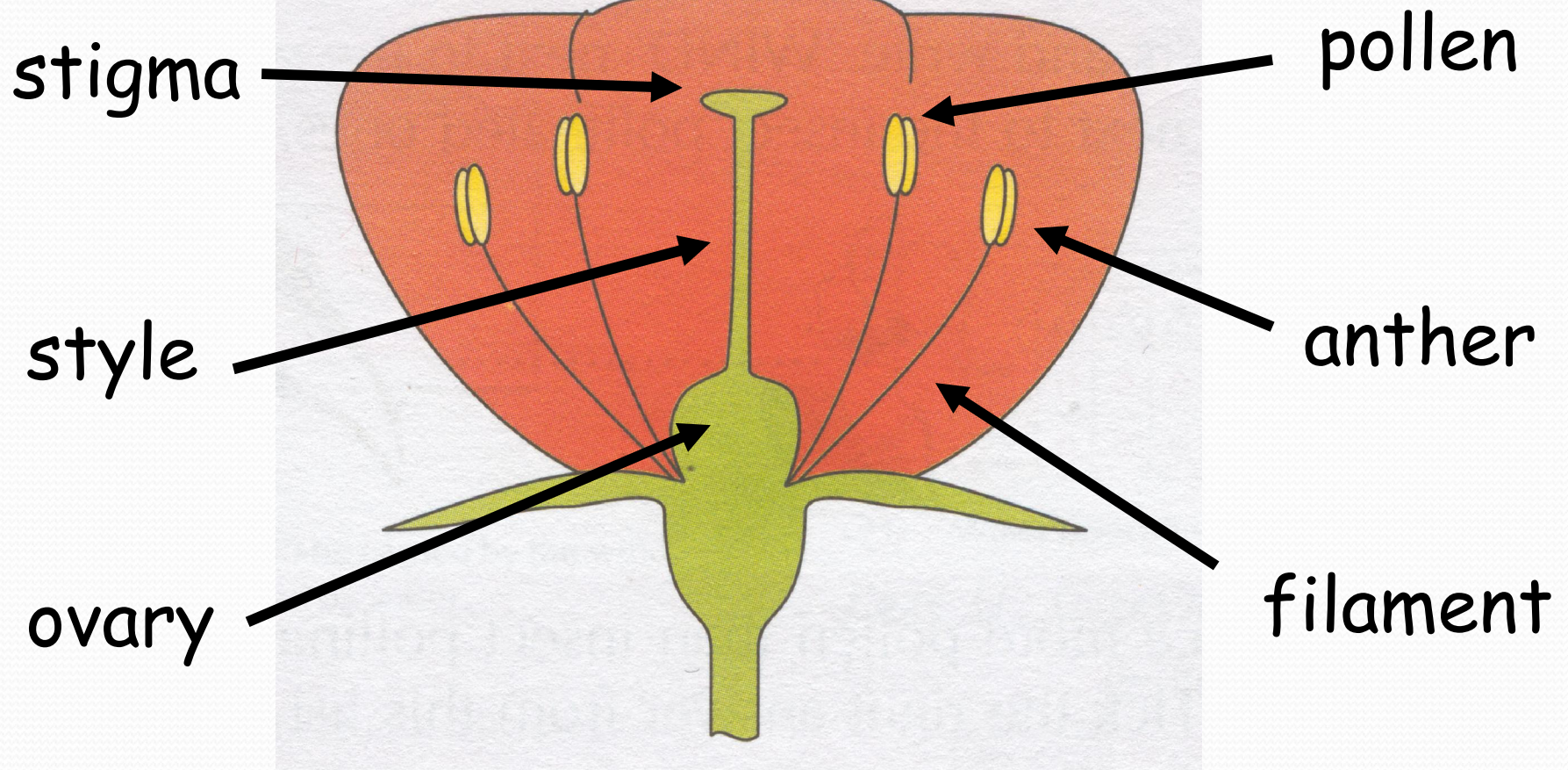


The parts of a flower

The eggs are fertilised and along with the ovule turn into seeds

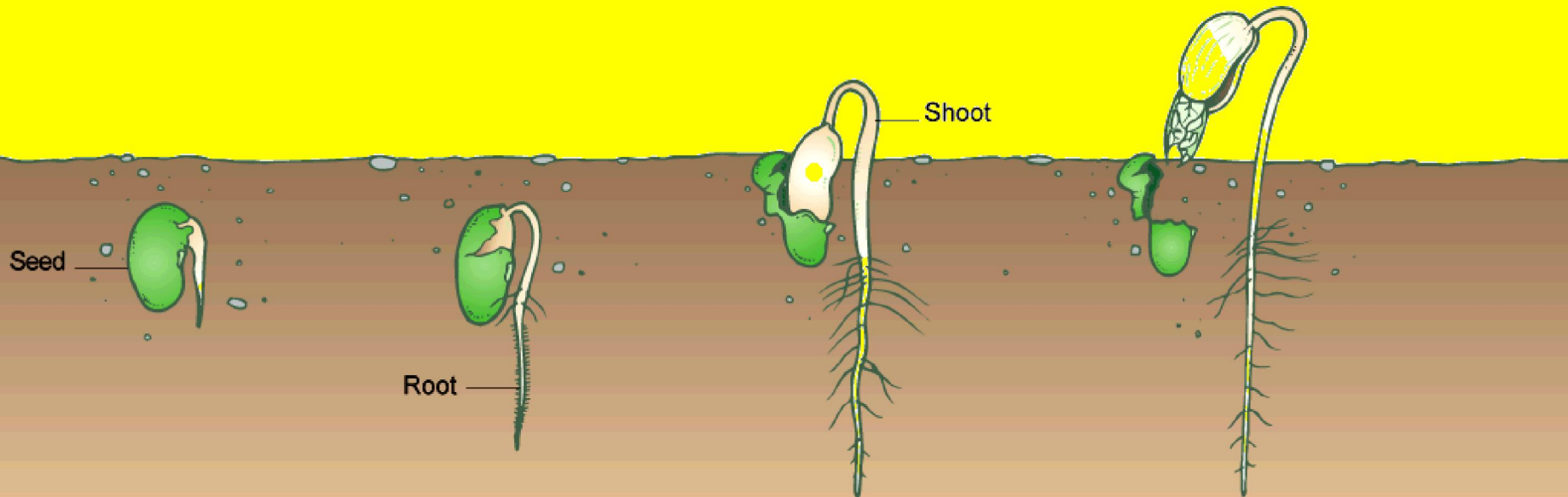


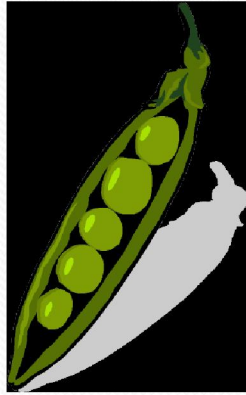
This is **Germination**
