Dear Parent / Guardian

We hope and pray you receive this letter in the best of health and Imaan.

Due to the recent announcement from the Prime Minister, Boris Johnson that all UK schools must close due to the spread of Coronavirus, we are writing to officially notify you of **Paradise Primary Schools closure.**

This is an extremely difficult situation which impacts us all, but we believe that the closure of schools is necessary to ensure the safety, health and wellbeing of everyone and prevent further spread of the virus.

The Prime Minister has advised that children should not be left with older grandparents or older relatives who may be particularly vulnerable to the Coronavirus.

Vulnerable children and children of key workers (As listed on the government website) will continue to be able to come into school as normal. Examples of these key workers include NHS staff, police and delivery drivers who need to be able to go to work. Vulnerable children include those who have a social worker and those with educational health and care plans.

Our staff have been working hard behind the scenes to devise learning packs to ensure that your child still has the opportunity to continue their studies remotely. All extra work will be uploaded on Class Dojo
