In Reading/Spag this term I will be learning to: Read and analyse fiction written by significant authors, performance poems and narrative poems before creating our own and performing them in the class. Read a range of texts and differentiate between instruction texts and explanation texts. Differentiate between main and subordinate clause and form sentences with relative clauses. Understand how adverbials, like adverbs, modify the noun.	In English this term I will be learning to: Discuss and analyse features of historical fiction to include poems Discuss and analyse events that took place during World War One. Compare books and plays and write play scripts. Identify features of good narrative performance poems before writing own versions. Rehearse different sentence types and expand understanding of how such grammatical components make writing detailed and interesting. Compare and give reasons for variations in how components function. Enquire about the length of wire in a circuit and the use of cells. Associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit
